MARRIAGE MOMENTS

"The harvest is abundant, but the laborers are few; so, ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for his harvest." Luke 10:2

Traditionally this passage has been applied to religious vocations, but laboring as a peacemaker is also a worthy vocation. As a married couple, you've probably learned ways to make peace with each other. Look for a way to use that skill across our contentious political divide today.

PARENTING POINTERS

Why do you want to be when you grow up? Jesus said, *"The harvest is abundant but the laborers are few."* Luke 10:2 Although this passage is usually applied to religious vocations, laboring as a peacemaker is also a worthy vocation. Talk to your children about how they can be peacemakers with their peers.

REFLECTIONS

"The harvest is abundant, but the laborers are few; so, ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for his harvest." Luke 10:2

The work Christ entrusted to his first disciples is also entrusted to us by virtue of our baptism. Stewardship is an invitation from God. It is an invitation to join in the work of the Church.
